<p>Monofocal Lens</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designed to provide clear distance vision • You will likely still need glasses for reading (and possibly distance vision) 			●	
<p>Astigmatism-Correcting Monofocal Lens</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrects both cataracts and astigmatism • Designed to provide clear distance vision without glasses • You will likely still need glasses for reading 			●	●
<p>Extended Vision Lens</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrects cataracts • Provides extended range of vision for distant and intermediate tasks and offers functional near vision for tasks like reading a menu or putting on makeup • You may still need glasses for reading fine print • Not designed to correct for astigmatism 	●	●	●	
<p>Next-Generation Trifocal Lens</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrects cataracts • Designed to provide a full range of vision- near, far and in-between • Not designed to correct for astigmatism • May need glasses 	●	●	●	
<p>Next-Generation Trifocal Toric Lens</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrects cataracts and astigmatism • Designed to provide a full range of vision- near, far and in-between • May need glasses 	●	●	●	●
